

Project-based focused and low system embedding




Professional accountability in the system; constructive unions

Bureaucratic accountability dominates; unions disrupt




Build district level capacity

Institutionalisation

The action of establishing something as a convention or norm in an organization or culture.



Systemic embedding

1. phased in state funding
2. ongoing research and evaluation
3. development of processes and products
4. medium to long-term planning
5. co-design with government
6. modest design
7. flexibility and adaptation

Impact investment

1. delivering competitive financial returns
